Type of Questions

Comparison – Types of Exam/test Question

No.	Type of Qs	Duration	Bloom's Tx
1	True/False	20 – 30s	C1 / C2
2	MCQ (Single Answered – FACT)	40 – 60s	C1 / C2
3	MCQ (Complex)	70 – 90s	C3 - C6
4	MCQ (Calculation)	2 – 5 minutes	C3 - C6
5	Fill-in the blanks (<i>Sentence completion</i>)	2 – 4 minutes	C1 / C2
6	Draw & label	3 – 5 minutes	C1 – C3
7	Match Qs	2 – 4 minutes	C1 / C2
8	Short Answers	2 – 4 minutes	C1 – C6
9	Problem Statement (Basic Math.)	5 – 10 minutes	C3 – C6
10	Data / Graph Analysis Qs	15 – 25 minutes	C3 – C6
11	Short Essay Qs	15 – 20 minutes	C3 – C6
12	Long Essays Qs	35 – 50 minutes	C3 – C6

EXAMPLE:

- 3 HOURS = 180 MINUTES = 60%
 - So... 10% bersamaan 30 minit
 - 30 MCQs = 30 MINUTES
 - 5 Short Essays x 15 minutes = 75 minutes
 - 2 Long Essays x 30 minutes = 60 minutes
- TOTAL = 30+75+60 = 165minutes (-15minutes)

ERROR!!!

• CORRECTION!!!

- 8 short essays x 15 minutes = 120 minutes + 30minutes of MCQs = 150minutes @ 2 ½ hours
- In your DCI (Faculty), it should be written as 50% for final exam; NOT 60%!!!

AFTER CORRECTION!!!

8 short essays x 15 minutes = 120 minutes + 30 minutes
of MCQs = 150 minutes @ 2 ½ hours

- **ALL 30 MCQs**
 - **LOTS (ie. C1 – C2 level)**
- **8 short essays**
 - **LOTS (C1 – C2) + HOTS (C3 – C4)**

Excellent Teaching

Good teaching is about PASSION as it is about

Excellent Teaching

Good teaching is about MENTORING between senior and junior faculty members, TEAMWORK and being RECOGNIZED and PROMOTED by one's peers

Good teaching is about STYLE

Good teaching is about CARING, NURTURING and DEVELOPING minds and talents

Excellent Teaching

This is very important – Good teaching is about humor

At the end of the day....Good Teaching is all about FUN, EXPERIENCING PLEASURE and INTRINSIC REWARDS, THOUGHTS BEING FORMED, in which becoming a better person



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
